



Junior Camp Guidelines

THE OREGON DISTRICT BOARD ADOPTED THE FOLLOWING RULES TO BE OBSERVED AT OREGON DISTRICT CHILDREN'S CAMP BY ALL WHO ATTEND:

DRESS STANDARDS FOR GIRLS:

- 1. Clothing must have a modest sleeve length. No sleeveless or cap sleeve clothing will be allowed.
- 2. Skirts/dresses must come to the knee (no slits above the knee).
- 3. No slits of any kind can be worn on the platform.
- 4. No clothing styles that are too tight or reveal the midriff.
- 5. No split skirts, skorts, slacks, gauchos, etc. may be worn at any time.
- 6. No clothing which depicts sinful images or activities (such as alcoholic beverage logos, worldly celebrities, singers, or crude cartoons).
- 7. No two-piece swimsuits. One-piece swimsuits only during swim sessions.
- 8. No makeup, nail polish or jewelry.

DRESS STANDARDS FOR BOYS:

- 1. No tank tops or open shirts, sleeves must have a modest length.
- 2. Full length pants.
- 3. No clothing styles that are too tight.
- 4. Hair must be neatly trimmed off the collar and above the ears following the natural hairline.
- 5. No clothing which depicts sinful images or activities, (such as alcoholic beverage logos, worldly celebrities, singers, or crude cartoons).
- 6. No hats may be worn during service or class periods.
- 7. No bikini swim trunks.
- 8. No makeup, nail polish or jewelry.

If a question should arise as to proper attire, the Children's Ministry Committee shall make the final decision.

ALL CAMPERS:

- 1. Each camper is expected to attend all classes during the daytime and all services in the evening.
- 2. No one will be permitted to leave the campgrounds after they have enrolled in camp without the express permission of a Children's Ministry Committee Member.
- 3. All accidents must be reported to your dorm supervisor.
- 4. Each camper will be expected to submit to those in authority while the camp is in operation. This includes your dorm supervisor and other staff members.
- 5. There will be no activity allowed which would discredit our church or camp.
- 6. Boys and girls will not be allowed to sit together during class time or evening services
- 7. "Lights Out" time will be determined by the Camp Principal.
- 8. You must have a "Restroom Pass" to go out of your dorm after "Lights Out".
- 9. Please do not litter.
- 10. All dorms must be clean and orderly before leaving the campground at the end of the week.
- 11. Cell phones must be surrendered to your counselor upon check-in. Phones will be released at the end of your stay or at times deemed appropriate by the Children's Ministry Committee.
- 12. No one is allowed in "Off Limits" areas.

CHILDREN'S CAMP WILL BE CLOSED TO NON-REGISTERED VISITORS.

ONLY ENROLLED CAMPERS, WHO ARE ENDORSED BY AN OREGON DISTRICT PASTOR, WILL BE ACCEPTED.
